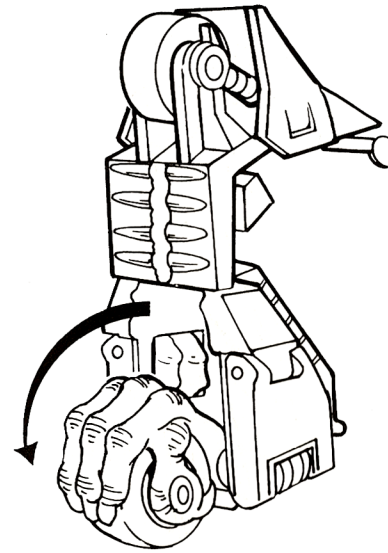
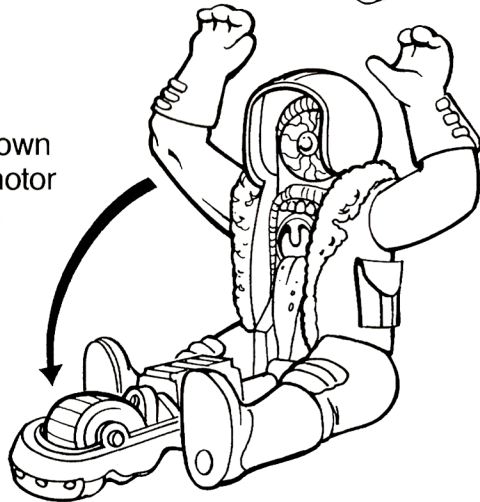
ASSEMBLY AND OPERATION

1. Bend legs and position figure on motor scooter by placing holes in feet onto pegs on floor. Bend arms so hands reach handlebar grips.

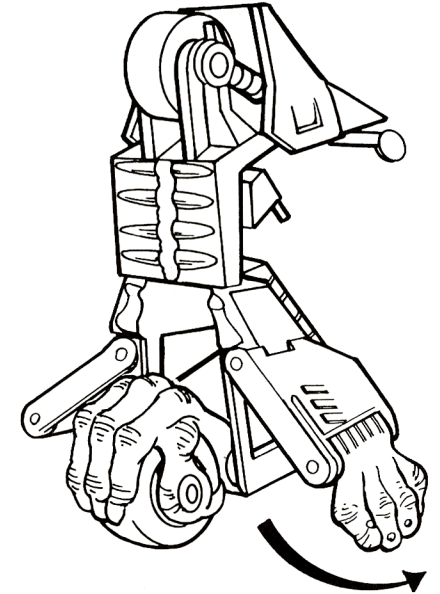

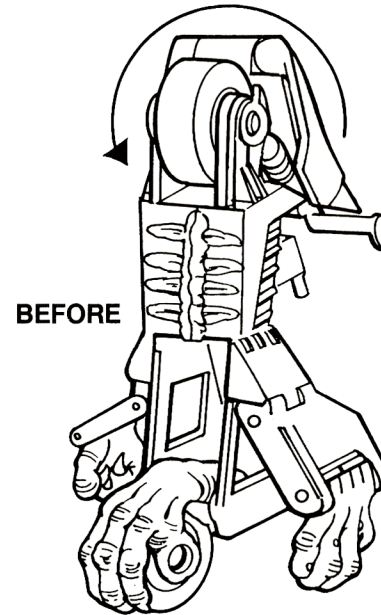
2. Remove figure from scooter and rotate arms up while in seated position.
3. Rotate helmet visor down to reveal ghost with motor and wheel.



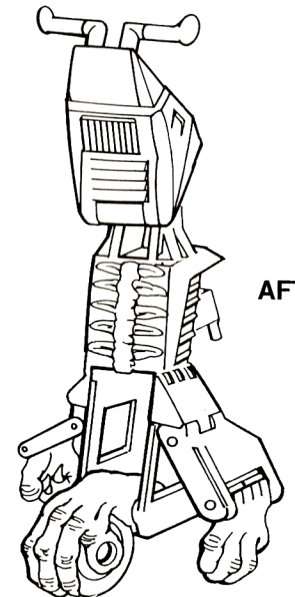
4. Rotate back wheel out to reveal middle claw and wheel assembly.



5. Lift both side panels out and rotate side claws to support ghost in upright position.

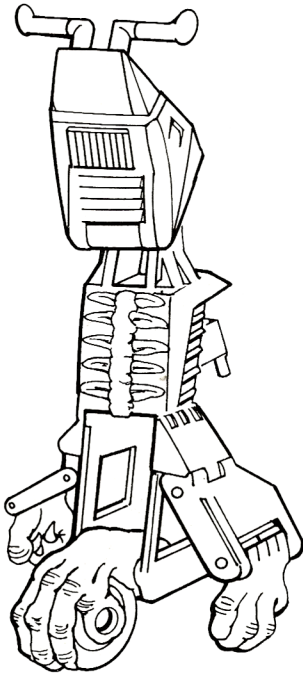

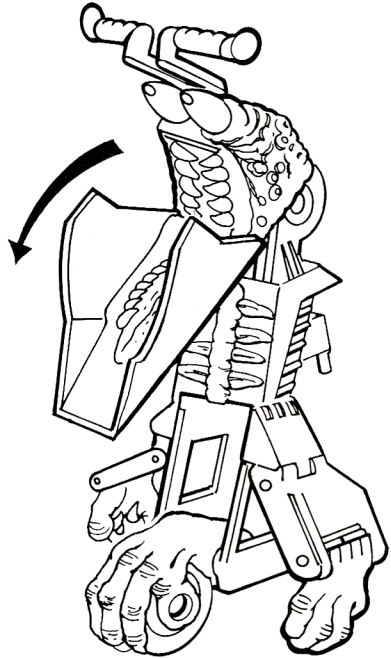

6. Rotate windshield and handlebar section over top of front wheel as shown in **BEFORE** and **AFTER** illustrations.

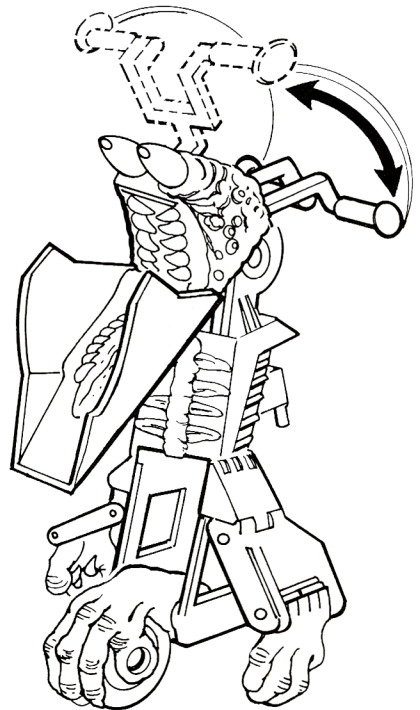

7. To expose mouth and eyes, pull down on windshield as shown in **BEFORE** and **AFTER** illustrations.



8. Handlebars become ghost's antenna and can be rotated up and down.
9. Reverse the sequence of procedures to convert the two ghosts back to the rider and cycle.
