In 1984, the movie Ghostbusters premiered. Although I didn't want to see it at first, I quickly fell in love with it and it has remained my favorite film.

In 1986, THE REAL GHOSTBUSTERS cartoon made its debut. Like its predecessor, I originally didn't care for it...but it grew on me (kind of like a spore, mold, or fungus) and is now my favorite television show.

In 1988, the comic book adaptation of THE REAL GHOSTBUSTERS arrived on the scene. The pattern continued; I didn't like it at first either!
