Dear NOW,

My son, age 4, received a Real Ghostbusters comic book for his birthday and many other Ghostbuster toys, because, like many young boys his age, Ghostbusters are very popular. Because it was a gift, I did not preview the magazine; if I had, I would never have purchased it for him. The content was not appropriate for a child his age and may not have been given as a gift, if the comic book had indicated on its cover, the ages appropriate for such a comic book. Even more upsetting and very frightening for my son was the horrifying FRIGHT NIGHT advertisement in the back of the comic book. The picture terrified him and has caused him a great deal of emotional stress. I'm very conscientious about what my child views on TV and the books he reads. I personally feel that the comic book is not appropriate for children under the age of 10-13 and recommend that you encourage your writers to upgrade the stories. I feel that children are being more and more exposed to violence and fright at an earlier age and just ask that from now on, please be more responsible with the stories and advertisements you use in your publication. Thank you for your consideration regarding my concerns in this matter.

Mrs. Grundner, I believe that yours is the first complaint we've ever recieved on the violence of The Real Ghostbusters, that does not, however, make it any less im-

portant. The

Real Ghostbusters follows the Saturday morning cartoon very closely. The book is also approved by the Comics Magazine Assoc., so I must say that it is improbable that we will change the format and gear it toward your son's age group. It may be that the book is too much for him at this stage. I am printing your letter out of concern. Should you read this, I would like to let you know of another title we carry, Slimer and the Real Ghostbusters. This comic is geared toward the age group 2-7 years. SLIMER has short simple stories with strong moral standards, activity pages and games. It is my suggestion to you that you satisfy your son's GB craving with this title until he reaches an appropriate Real Ghostbusters
