Kids on the Go... the Safe Way

When it comes to teaching their children the dos and don'ts of school bus safety, parents can— and should— take the lead. Here are a few reminders to review and rehearse with your youngsters before school begins—and from time to time the rest of the year. Children should:

- Get to the bus stop on time.
- Be well-behaved.
- Stay back from the curb when the bus is coming, and line up single file.
- Sit down and face forward as soon as they get on the

- bus. No playing in the aisles, no feet in the aisles, either. Hands, arms, and heads belong inside the bus at all times, not outside the windows.
- Keep the noise level down—way down!

Getting off the bus is when there is the biggest chance of an accident happening. Children must be sure to obey the following rules:

- Once the children get off the bus, those children who must cross the street should step back from the door and wheels.
- They should walk along

the roadside toward the front of the bus.

- They should stop and make sure they can see the bus driver's face (this way, the children will know that the bus driver can see their faces, too). Once the driver and the children can see each other's faces, the children should walk past the bus's bumper and into the street for the width of the bus.
 - Before they go past the bus and across the street, children must look both ways to check for oncoming traffic.

Egon's Quick Tips Did you know?

The key to removing simple splinters easily is right in your kitchen cabinet. Just apply a small amount of vegetable oil around the splinter. Then, wait a bit to let the oil make the splinter slippery enough to slide right out with the help of a tweezer.



What's the most important thing a kid can do to be a safe bicycler? Wear a helmet. When you shop for a helmet, look for one that has a sticker that says the helmet is approved by the American National Standards Institute or the Snell Foundation. This will tell you if the helmet will do a good job of protecting your child. The helmet should fit properly and be worn even on short rides.
