# Egon Spengler's PARENTS' GUIDE FOR HEALTH AND SAFETY



f you're a kid, October means only one thing: Halloween. If you're a parent, Halloween means something else: time to remind your own trick-ortreaters that safety is more important than all the candy in the neighborhood. Good health on Halloween means more than not getting a stomachache from too many sweets; it means being safe. Try these tips for a Halloween that's a real treat!

· Use make-up on your chil-

dren instead of masks.
Masks can have sharp edges
and can even make breathing difficult. Your own trickor-treaters will be safer,
more comfortable, and able
to see more easily.

 Costumes should be flame-resistant. Also, make sure they're short enough to keep your child from tripping on them.


 Make sure your kids carry and use a flashlight if they go trick-or-treating after dark—or even at dusk.

## How is a Turtle Like a Raw Chicken?

aw chicken meat has lately as a possible source of salmonella, a bacteria that can make you sick. What's the connection? A sick pet turtle or one that's been kept in dirty water can also give people salmonella. If your children are shopping around for a pet turtle, they should pick one that is clean, alert, and eating. If its tank is filled with dirty water, if the turtle's eyes are swollen, or if it has white spots, choose another. Once your children bring their new pet home, the turtle tank should be filled with clean water at least once also be kept clean.

## When Not to Give Aspirin to Kids

Parents' alert: There is scientific evidence that aspirin is linked to Reve Syndrome, a disease that can be fatal. Reve Syndrome most often strikes children aged 5 to 14 who are getting over chickenpox or flu. It is suggested that non-aspirin products be given to children with chickenpox or flu. Because of the connection between aspirin and Reye Syndrome, you should consult your physician about when you can safely give your child aspirin.



## **Twilight Zones**

We've all been in the twilight zone, that time between day and night. You may call it dusk or sunset. We call it the time of day when drivers find it most difficult to see. Be-

cause of the changing fall colors, twilight in autumn is even more difficult to drive in than other times of the year. Make sure your children play only in safe areas at dusk. Wearing light-colored clothing makes them more visible to drivers. If they are bicycling, they should use lights and have reflectors on the bike. Your riders will be seen better if they wear light-colored, reflective clothing. Bicyclists of any age should always wear a helmet.



## E.G.O.N'S Q.U.I.C.K T.I.P.S



Parents can start their kids on the road to a more fit future just by not insisting that the children eat when they're full. Since children as young as six weeks seem to know when they're full, parents can help their children do what comes naturally.

Nosebleed know-how is something most parents can use. For minor nosebleeds, pinch the nostrils shut and hold for five minutes. Don't let your child walk around, and don't tilt back his or her head. The child should be sitting up. This is to prevent children—especially small children—from swallowing and choking on the blood.


Dear Jamie:
